

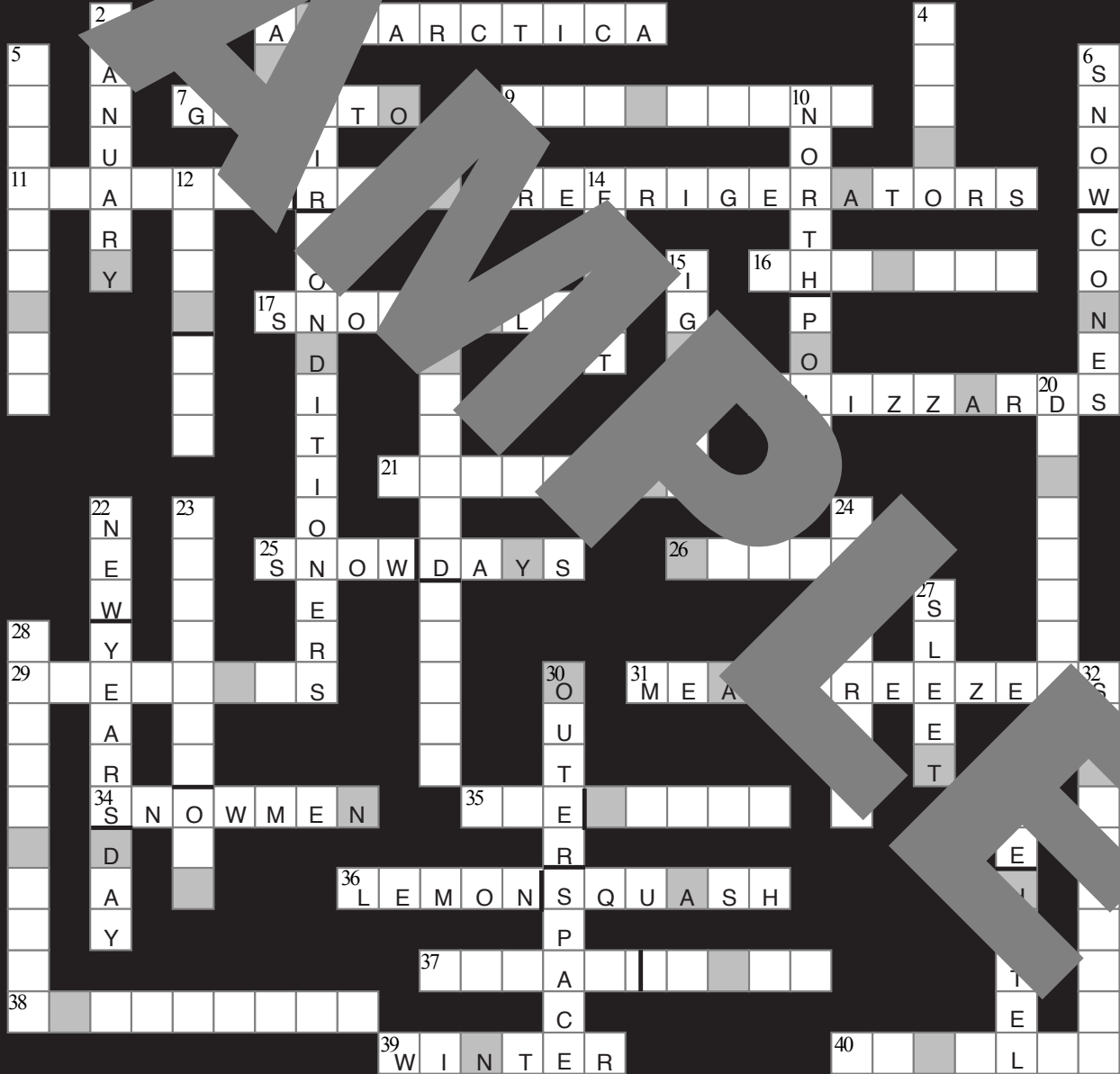

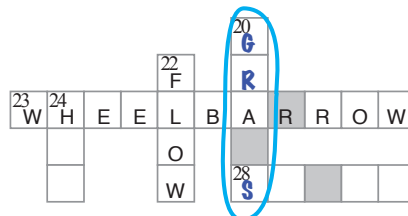

Introduction  
Crossword puzzles are a fun way for students to practice many basic English skills including spelling, building vocabulary, offering hints, working with numbers (1, 2, 3) and ordinals (1st, 2nd, 3rd) and the while assisting each other in solving the puzzle.

Each pair work puzzle has two worksheets. **Students A & B** have half of the answers on their worksheets. By working together, they will eventually be able to complete the entire puzzle.

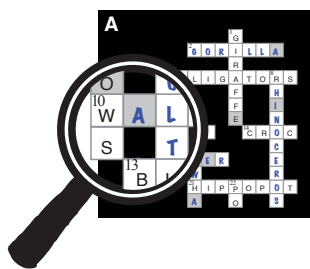
If **Student A** is still in the dark, no problem. She simply asks her partner for the missing letters. For example:

- What's the first letter?
- What's the second letter?
- What's the last letter? etc.



Once **Student A** has written GRASS on her worksheet, students reverse roles and **Student B** asks for a hint, which **Student A** reads from her worksheet. Eventually, all of the answers will be filled in and the puzzle will be complete.

**Tip**  
Enlarge the puzzle when printing.



All puzzles have two parts. In **Part One**, students complete the puzzle and in **Part Two** they fill in the message bar printed below the puzzle.

**Part One**

To begin, **Student A** selects any blank answer on her worksheet as in the following example from the **Yard & Garden** crossword puzzle:



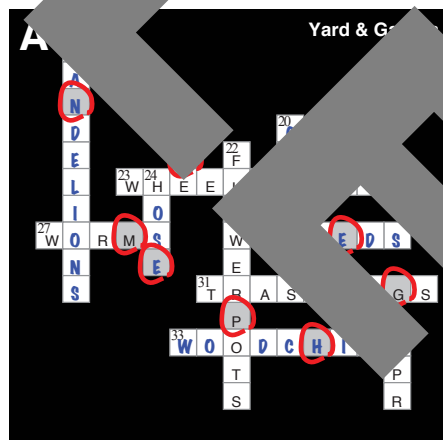
**Student A** asks her partner: *What's number twenty down?* She knows that the 3rd letter is an A and that the word has five letters.

**Student B** reads the hint as printed on his worksheet: *This green plant covers lawns and golf courses.*

If **Student A** can not think of the answer, (GRASS) she asks her partner for another hint (not printed). He may say, for example:

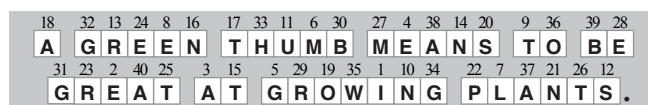
- It rhymes with class.*
- You cut it with a lawnmower.*
- It also covers ruby and football fields.*

Scattered throughout the puzzle are gray boxes as shown in the graphic above. Since students have filled in the answers, the letters written in the boxes need to be transferred into the message bar below the puzzle.



The blue lettering indicates the answers that a student has filled in.

The letters printed in the gray boxes (circled in red above) need to be entered into the message bar underneath the puzzle. When finished, it should look like this:



If students make any spelling mistakes, the errors will appear in the message.

## Messages

**Puzzle #1** Adjective **Shiritori** is based on a Japanese game called Shiritori. Someone says a word such as **Porcupine**. The next person must say a word using the last letter of the previous word - **E**. For example **Eggplant**. The next player then says a word beginning with **T**. The next player says a word beginning with **R**. The next player says a word beginning with **Rabbit** or **Robot** or any other word beginning with the letter **R**.

One answer in the puzzle book is:

24 MYSTEROIOUS SIMPL E X P E N S I V E

The black boxes either end or begin a word according to the rules. The above answer is made of three (unrelated) words: MYSTEROIOUS, SIMPLE and EXPENSIVE.

\*\*\***Puzzle #15 Movies Stars** requires three students. This puzzle has three worksheets: **A**, **B** and **C**.

## Ranking

All of the puzzles are ranked with stars. **Puzzles #1 ~ #3** are ranked with two stars because they are less difficult.



**Puzzles #4 ~ #24** are ranked in order from 2 ½ to 3 ½ stars.

**Puzzle #25 Hospitals** is the most difficult with 4 stars.



## Final Tip

Since some students will inevitably overhear neighboring students saying the answer, it's a good idea to stagger the starting point.

One pair begins working from the top of the worksheet. An adjacent pair starts halfway down the puzzle, yet another pair starts near the bottom.
