# Introduction

Pair work crossword puzzles are a fun way for students to practice many basic English skills including reading, building vocabulary, offering hints, working with numbers (1, 2, 3) and ordinals (1st, 2nd, 3rd) and articles (a, an & the) while assisting each other in spelling.

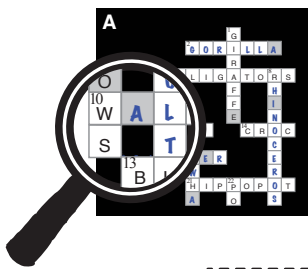
Each pair work puzzle has two worksheets. **Students A & B** have half of the answers printed on their worksheets. By working together, they will eventually be able to complete the entire puzzle.

If **Student A** is still in the dark, no problem. He simply asks his partner for the missing letters. For example:

- What's the first letter?
- What's the second letter?
- What's the fourth letter? etc.



Once **Student A** has written OVERALLS on his worksheet, students reverse roles and **Student B** asks for a hint which **Student A** reads from his worksheet. Eventually, all of the answers will be filled in and the puzzle will be complete.

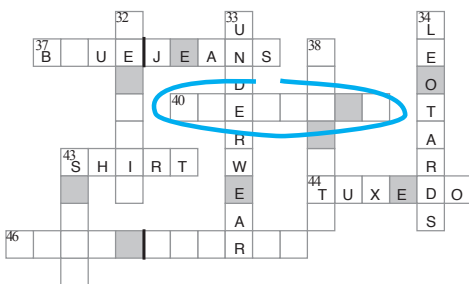


**Tip**  
Enlarge the puzzle when printing.

All puzzles have two parts. In **Part One**, students complete the puzzle and in **Part Two** they fill in the message bar printed below the puzzle.

## Part One

To begin, **Student A** selects any **blank** answer on his worksheet as in the following example from the **Clothing** crossword puzzle:



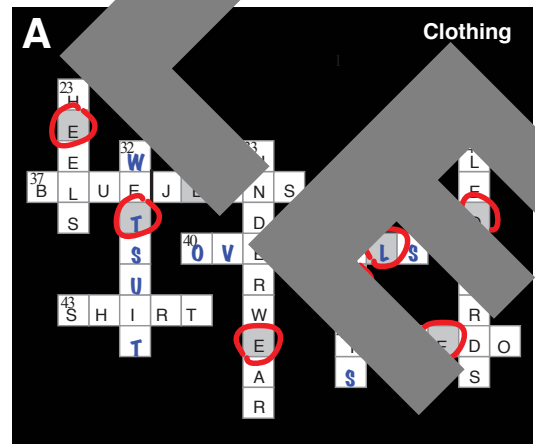
**Student A** asks his partner: *What's number thirty forty across?* He knows that the 3rd letter is an **E**.

**Student B** reads the hint as printed on her worksheet: *What many farmers wear.*

If **Student A** can not think of the answer, (OVERALLS) he asks his partner for another hint (not printed). She may say, for example:

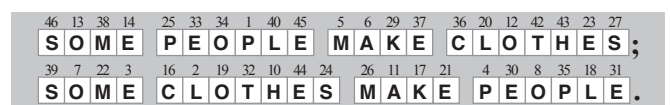
- They protect people's clothes.*
- They cover the whole body from feet to neck.*
- They usually have suspenders.*

Some boxes in the puzzle are gray boxes as shown in the example below. Once students have filled in the answers, the letters written in the boxes need to be transferred into the message bar below the puzzle.



The blue lettering indicates the answers that a student has filled in.

The letters printed in the gray boxes (circled in red above) need to be entered into the message bar underneath the puzzle. When finished, it should look like this:



If students make any spelling mistakes, the errors will appear in the message.

Puzzle #1 is a little different. As the title suggests, the letters are printed **side Down** and **Backward** as well as the

**\*\*Puzzle #9 Nouns Shiritori** is based on a Japanese word game called Shiritori. Some people say a word such as pineapple. The next person must say a word using the last letter of pineapple - E. For example Elephant. The next player then says a word beginning with a T such as Tomato (because elephant ends with a T). The next word might be Olive or Omelet or any other word beginning with the letter O.

One answer in the puzzle looks like this:

13 B R U S H A T O R N A D O

The gray boxes either end or begin a new word according to the rules. The above answer is made of three (unrelated) words: BRUSH, HAT and TORNADO.

**Puzzle #9** does not have a message bar at the bottom.

**Ranking**

All of the puzzles are ranked with stars. Puzzles #1 ~ #4 are ranked with two stars because they are less difficult.



**Puzzles #5 ~ 24** are ranked in order from 2 1/2 to 3 1/2 stars.

**Puzzle #25 Jobs (2)** is the most difficult with 4 stars.



**Final Tip**

Since some students will inevitably overhear neighboring pairs saying the answers, it's a good idea to stagger the starting point.

One pair begins working for half of the worksheet. An adjacent pair begins halfway through the puzzle, yet another pair begins at the bottom.
